

## **Analysis of Online Teaching-learning Process - 2020-2021**

The Institution has conducted online student satisfaction survey on Online Teaching - Learning process. The Institution prepared the questionnaire to touch all the nooks and corners of online Teaching-learning process. The questionnaire is consists of 10 questions with 5 options (ABCDE) just to get true and honest responses of the students. The report of this survey is analyzed as below:

Q1 - How much of the syllabus was covered in online Teaching - learning process?

- Almost 85 % students' preferred 'B' option for this as a response to this question. It means that 70% to 84%. Of the syllabus was covered by online teaching learning process.

Q2 - How well did the teachers prepare for online Teaching?

- For this question almost 90% students have responded to 'B' option 'Satisfactorily! It means teachers prepared well for online teaching to the satisfaction of the students.

Q3 - How well were the teachers able to communicate while reading online?

- Almost 85% de student responded to B 'option 'sometimes effective: After all face to face teaching is more effective and communicative than online teaching online teaching falls short in communicating knowledge.

Q4 - The teacher's approach to online teaching can best be described as...

- The 90% response is to B 'option' i.e. very good. The teachers tried their level best to satisfy their students with proper approach even in COVID - 9 pandemic period.

Q5- Fairness of the internal evaluation process online by the teachers?

- 80% students selected mostly 'A' option 'Always fair'. Actually internal evaluation was online examination as per the guidelines by the university and students also responded without fear and fault.

Q6 - The Institution provides multiple opportunities for online teaching learning process?

- Majority of students strongly responded to 'A' option i.e. Strongly agree! It does mean that Institutions provided multiple opportunities for online
