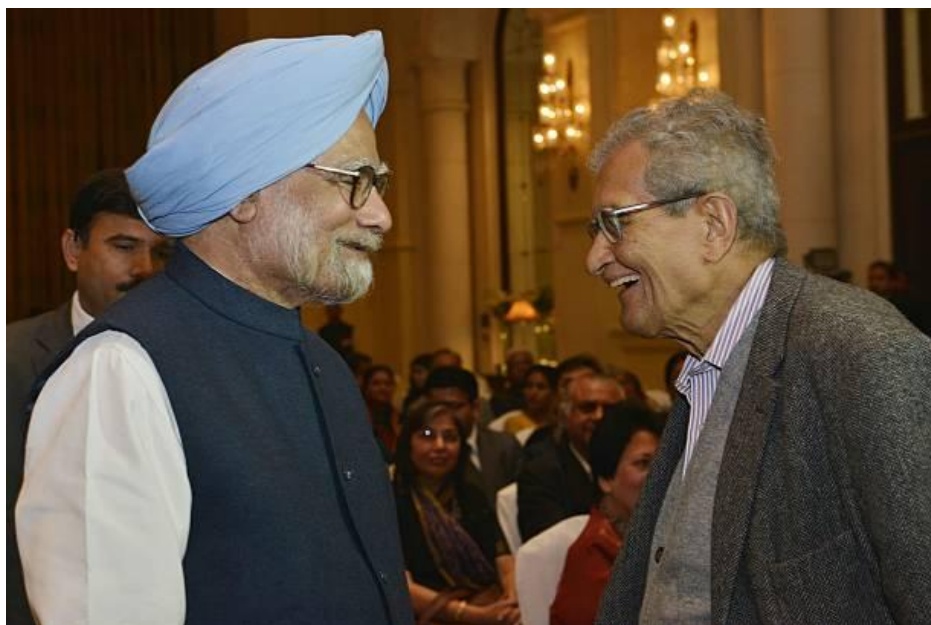

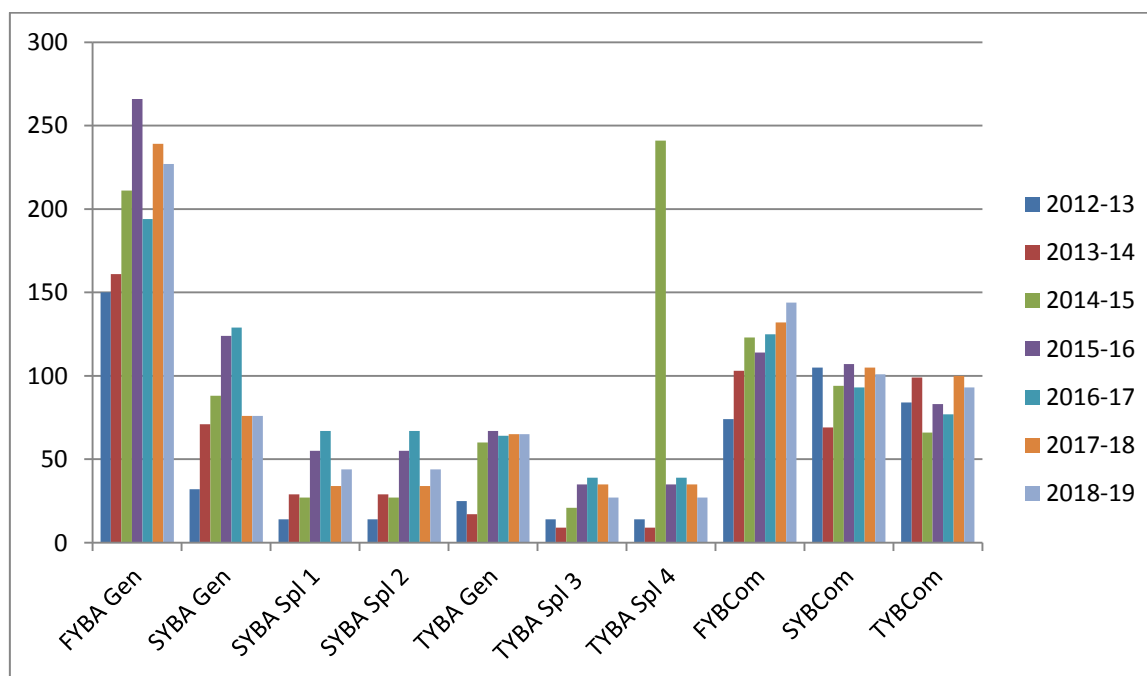

Academic Year 2012-13 To2018-19



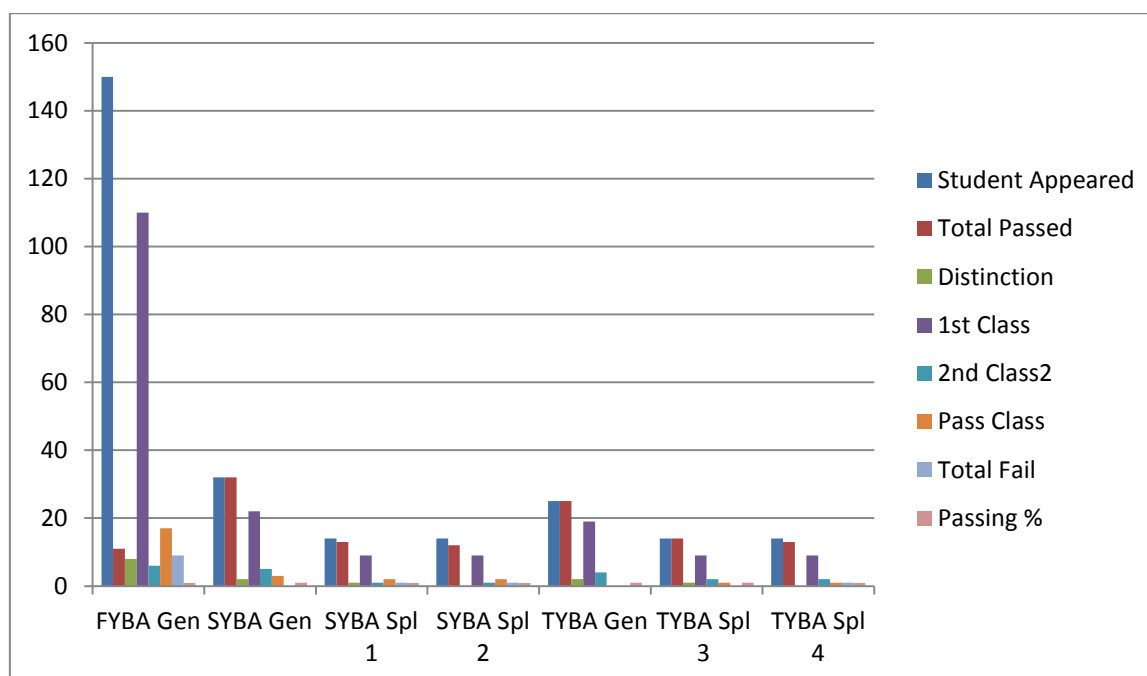

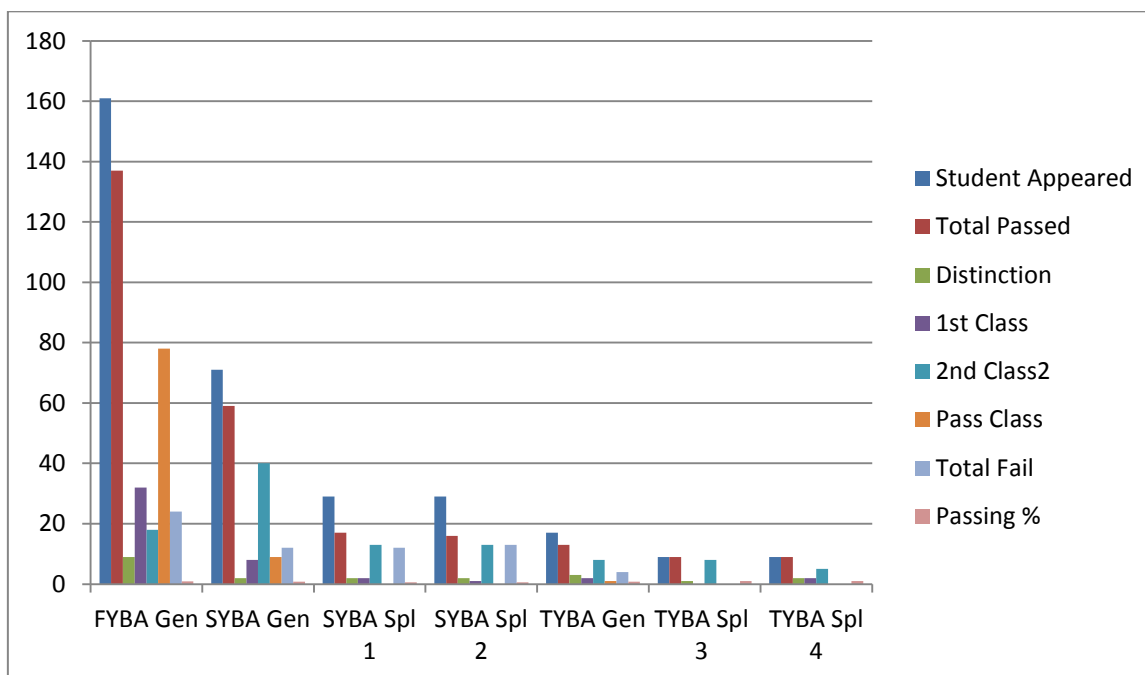

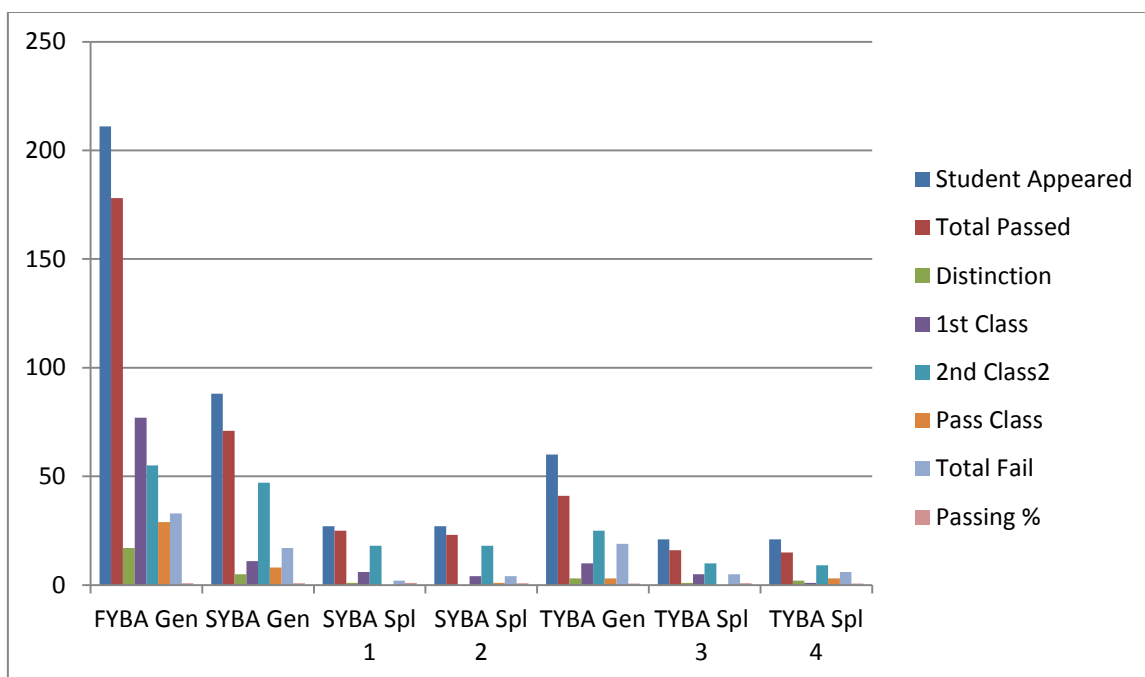
Academic Year 2012-13



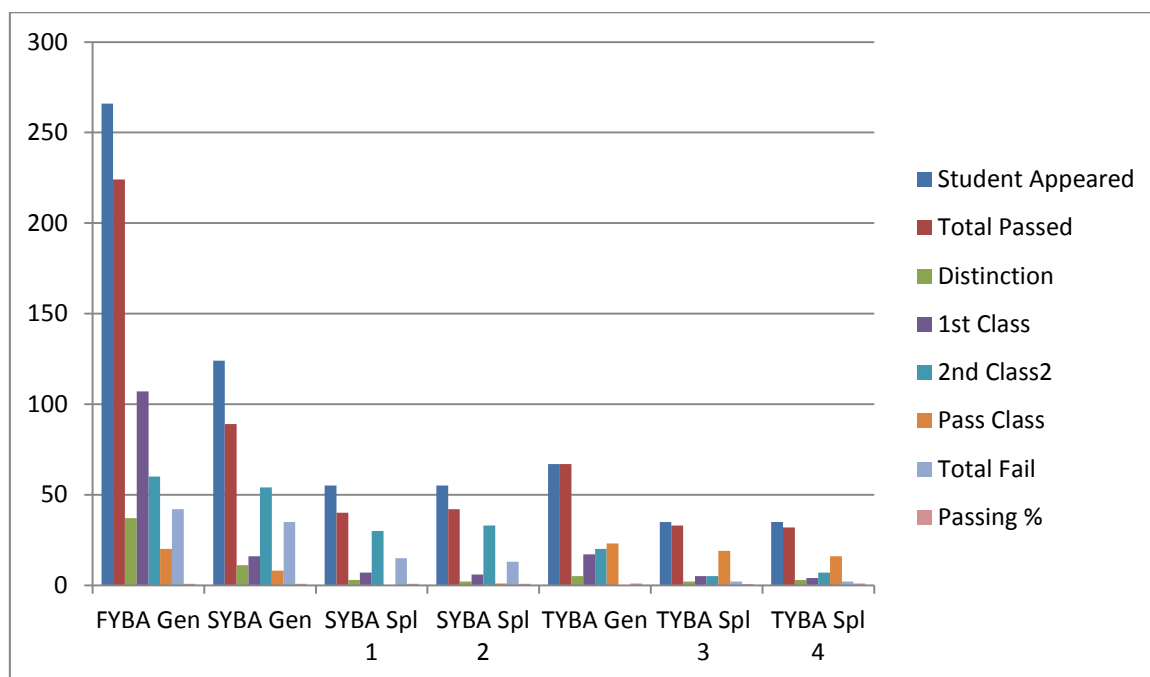
Academic Year 2013-14



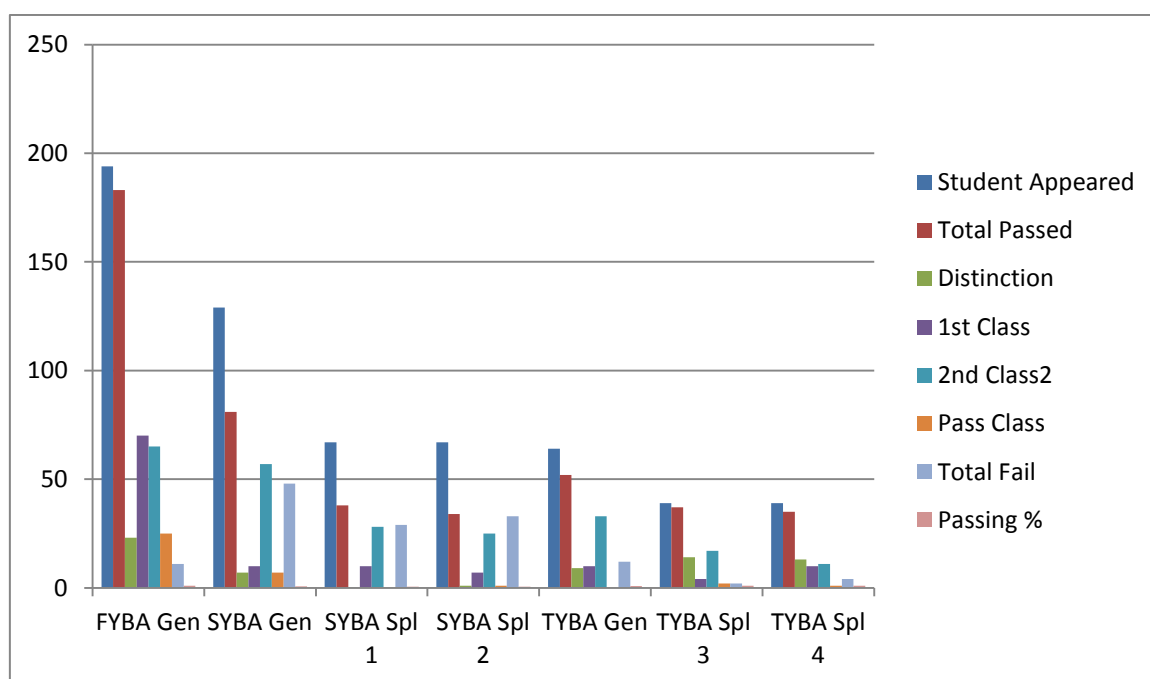

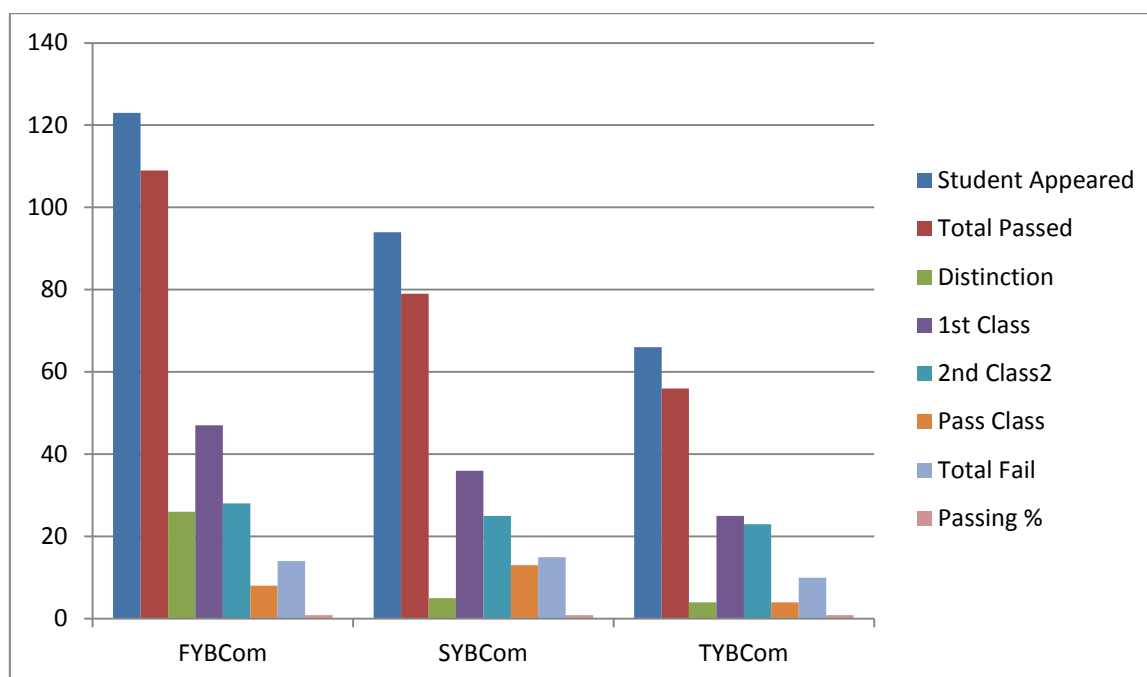

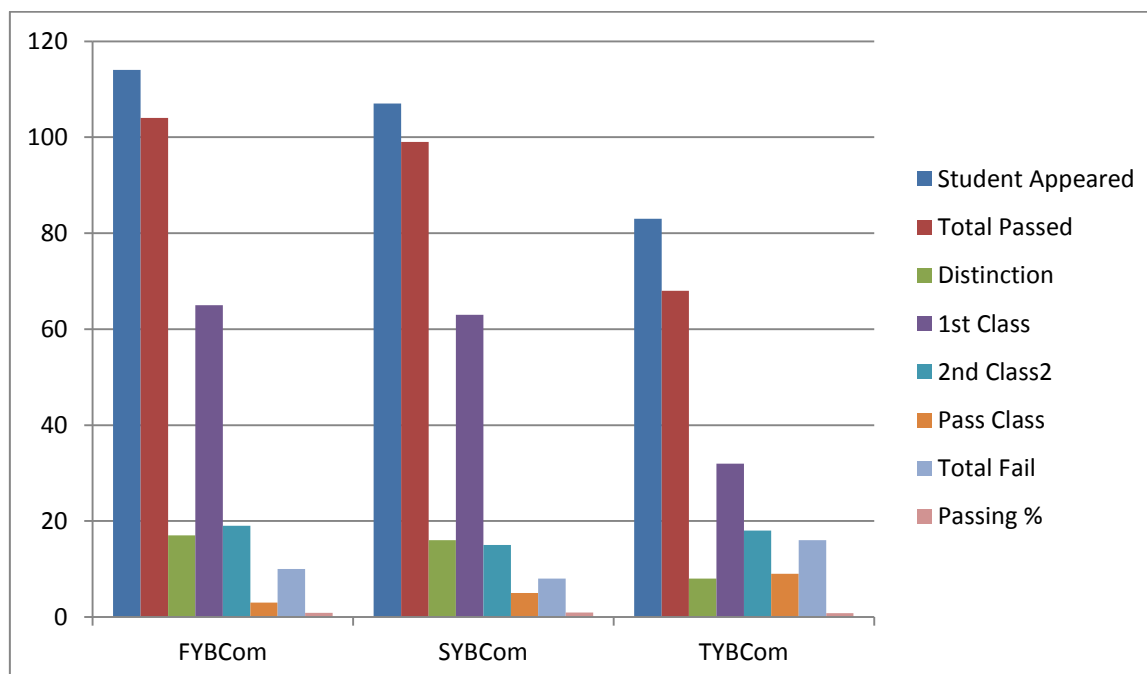
Academic Year 2013-14



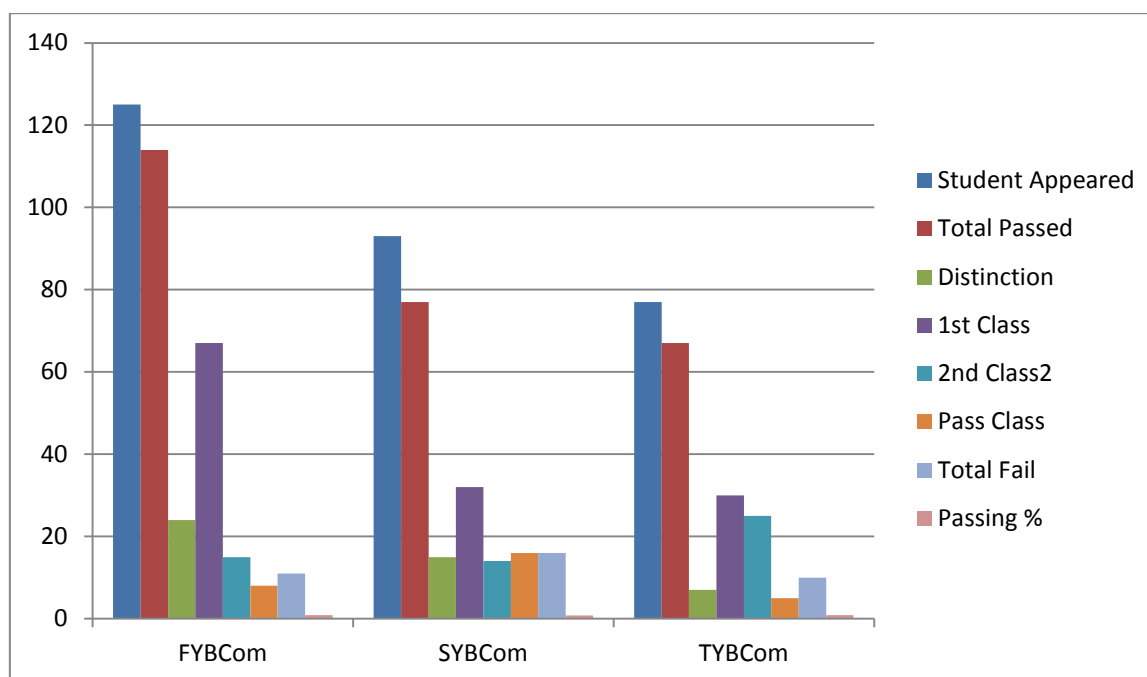

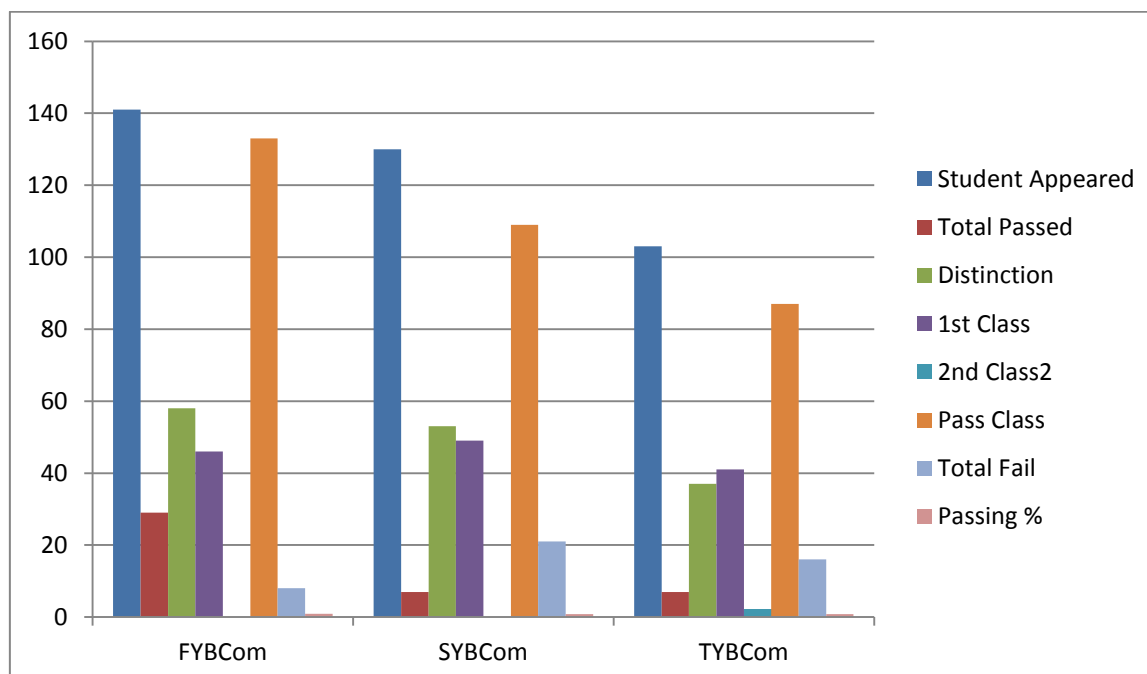
