Action Taken Report of IQAC (2020-2021)

As per the decisions taken in the IQ AC meeting held on 11/01/2021 are seriously worked out and put forward for further actions and process. They are as below:

- 1) Discussion on third cycle NAAC accreditation of the Institution
 All the members unanimously decided to overcome the weaknesses of the Institution and prepare better for the next cycle of accreditation. The recommendation by NAAC Peer Team are taken into consideration and the Institute decided to fulfill all the compliances.
- 2) Proposals of teachers under CAS.The teachers Prof. S. B. Tadari (Economics)

The teachers - Prof. S. B. Tadari (Economics) Prof. D. V. Wankhede (English) Mr. P. M. Dongre (Librarian) and Dr. J.D. Gopal (History) submitted their proposals to IQAC. The expert committee went through all the proposals and gave some suggestions and corrections. After corrections the proposals were sent for further action.

- 3) Online Teaching-learning process in COVID-19 Pandemic period IQAC played a leading part in this period and guided all the teaching faculty to form groups of students as per their respective subjects. Accordingly teachers started online teaching with suitable Apps VIZ Google meet, zoom, Google class, website lectures etc. IQAC then conducted students' satisfaction survey on online teaching learning process.
- 4) Online correspondence to the University and other offices concerned.

 Due to COVID-19 pandemic period it was must to have online correspondence for office purposes. To avoid further problems and difficulties, IQAC warned all the teaching and non-teaching staff to have online correspondence to the concerned.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic period it was highly impossible for the students to participate face to face in the competitions. As per the decision in IQAC meeting, students were allowed to participate in online competitions and activities.
- 6) E-learning facility for students and the staff

As it was the demand and need of the students and the staff, IQAC decided to have the access for this facility. The central library of the college played a vital role in making available the facility now in the library e-learning facility is available with QR codes. Students and the staff can have remote access to this facility. During the pandemic period students and staff was

away from the institution. So this facility was the only resource for them. Library became. "The Knowledge Resource Centre" for all.

7) Participation in NIRF:

It was decided in the meeting that the Institution should participate in NIRF Schemes. Accordingly the file was prepared with proper information and sent to the concerned agency of NIRF IQAC received the report of participation from the concerned office.

8) Preparation of Research Centre in the Institution

It was the need of time to have a research center in the Institution as there are five research guides in the Institution It was the need of time to have a research center in the Institution as there are five research guides in the Institution, VIZ - Dr. B.N. Patil (History), Dr.W. S. Wale (Marathi) Dr.J. V Patil (Hindi), Dr. P. B-Sonawane (English) and Dr. J. D. Gopal (History). The IQAC prepared a proposal for a Research Center and submitted it to the University. Accordingly, the University sent a committee for primary enquiry and investigation. The committee went through all the norms rules and regulations. Finally the committee gave the positive remarks to establish the research centre. The sanction letter for the Research centre is awaited.

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
